ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to apply for the Lynn Hispanic Scholarship Fund you must meet all of the following criteria:

- Must be a graduating, Lynn high school senior who is Hispanic or of Hispanic ancestry.
- Must be a U.S. citizen or a U.S permanent Resident residing in Lynn, Massachusetts.
- Must be accepted at a 2 or 4 year accredited institution of higher education as a full-time, undergraduate student pursuing an academic discipline.
- Student must be enrolled in a college or university program during the fiscal year following the grant award in order to receive scholarship payment.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

The LHSF awards at least four scholarships per academic year to graduating Hispanic seniors from each of the Lynn high schools. It is essential that you meet the eligibility criteria and that you submit a completed application by the deadline. Please type all parts of the application. Ensure that all attachments contain your full name.

Your completed application must be mailed to the LHSF address below and post-marked no later than March 31, 2010. The LHSF is not responsible for mail lost or delayed by the postal system. No exception of deadline will be made. All decisions are final. **All applicants will be notified by mail by May 1, 2010. Winners and parent(s) must attend the awards ceremony as a condition of the award.**

Award checks will be mailed to the students late in September 2010 and early February 2011 after the students send us proof of their schedule and registration.

The following five parts must be submitted together to constitute a complete application:

- Part I **Complete ALL sections of the application.** Note that Section D, Student Certification and Consent, requires your signature and date as well as the parent or guardian signature if you are less than 18 years of age.
- Part II **300-Word Essay** Describe how your Hispanic ethnicity influences your educational aspirations and, by fulfilling them, how you will give back to your Lynn Community. Essay must be typed double-space.
- Part III **Transcripts:** Submit a high school transcript of your most recent academic work.
- Part IV **2010-2011 Federal Student Aide Report (SAR).** In addition to completing Section C of the application, attach a copy of all pages of your SAR.
- Part V **College Acceptance** Attach a copy of the acceptance letter from the college or university.
- Part VI **Letter of Recommendation** Submit one (1) letter of recommendation from a school official, a past or present employer or from a community leader.
